

## Instructions to Authors:

1. Original, high-quality technical research work (which are currently not under review or under consideration for publication in any journal or conference proceedings) associated with any core/interdisciplinary domain of mechanical engineering are invited as papers for presentation in the 3<sup>rd</sup> International Conference on Mechanical Engineering (INCOM 2026). For a detailed list of the tracks and sub-tracks of the conference, please refer to the website of the conference (<https://www.incomju.com/>).
2. **4-page (A4) double column** manuscript typed in **English (Font - Times New Roman)** is to be submitted through the **online manuscript submission system** given in the conference website. Submission of papers through email is strictly prohibited and will not be considered under any circumstances.
3. The author submitting the manuscript (and the mail ID associated with the submission) will be designated as the corresponding author and corresponding mail ID, respectively. This information cannot be altered/modified once the submission is completed.
4. At the time of submission, **a preferred track and an alternate track** for the manuscript must be provided. Please note that depending on the opinion of the technical committee and/or reviewers' recommendation the track of a particular paper may be changed. In that case, the corresponding author will be informed through mail.
5. Plagiarism Check: Authors need to **mandatorily submit a plagiarism check report** (prepared through iThenticate or Turnitin) along with the manuscript at the time of submission. **The similarity index must be less than 20%.**
6. The manuscript must contain the following information – **Title of paper, Author names** (initials followed by surname/last name), **Affiliation** (including Department, Institute, Country etc.), **Abstract** (Maximum 150 words), **Keywords** (3 – 5).
7. The manuscript should be sub-divided into logical sections as appropriate (For example, Introduction, Mathematical/Problem Formulation, Experimental Methods, Materials, Results and Discussions, Conclusions etc.). There must be a section for references. Acknowledgement may be added after Conclusion section.
8. Figures and Tables should be numbered, captioned and placed within the text column (except for large figures/tables in exceptional cases) preferably at the beginning of or at the end of a column as close as possible to the text associated with them.
9. **Manuscripts must be prepared strictly adhering to the prescribed format.** Detailed guidelines for preparation of the manuscript are provided as a template file, which is available in the conference website. A detailed formatting checklist is also available in the conference website. Manuscripts not conforming to the guidelines will not be processed further.
10. **All manuscripts will undergo a thorough peer review** and the criteria for acceptance is based on quality, originality, technical content, relevance and alignment with the theme of the conference.
11. **Do not submit the same manuscript twice/multiple times** for any reason. **Duplicate submissions will be rejected.**
12. **At least one of the authors** of accepted papers must register for the conference **within the registration deadline** for presenting his/her work. **An unregistered paper will not be included in the proceedings of the conference.**
